LUCIE IDIAMEY-GABA, being duly sworn, deposes and says:

- 1. I am a parent of a minor child, D.B., who attends Brownsville Academy High School ("Brownsville"), located at 1150 E New York Ave, Brooklyn, NY 11212. As such, I am familiar with the facts and circumstances in this matter, and I submit this affidavit in support of the Verified Petition and in opposition to the proposed re-siting of Aspirations Diploma Plus to building K907. I have read the Verified Petition and know the contents thereof. The same is true to the best of my knowledge and belief based on my experience as a Brownsville parent and my child's experience at Brownsville. As to the matters herein stated to be alleged upon information and belief, I believe them to be true.
 - 2. My son and I reside in Brooklyn in School District 19.
- 3. The DOE proposed to re-site Aspirations Diploma Plus to building K907, which currently houses both Brownsville Academy and New Visions AIM I.
- 4. Before attending Brownsville, my son attended another high school in Manhattan. He struggled with attendance issues and with being on time.
- 5. My son is completing his second year at Brownsville and has had a great experience. Since switching schools, his attendance has improved and the wonderful staff have inspired him to become an active member of the school community.

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- 6. My son is now involved in clubs and actively assists teachers. He also played basketball until he injured his leg. I am concerned that if the co-location occurs, there will not be enough space or resources for my son to remain an active member of the school community.
- 7. I am very concerned that if the colocation were to occur, the school would be overcrowded. According to the DOE's Educational Impact Statement (EIS), the co-location will add up to 175 students to K907.
- 8. As it is, K907 has limited space. They need more classrooms and more space on their own. I am concerned about Brownsville having to share the cafeteria and other shared spaces. This overcrowding will limit the effectiveness of resources my son needs to thrive.
- 9. English is my son's second language. Due to this challenge, he receives extra resources during instruction and when taking exams. These types of services are not mentioned in the EIS. I am concerned how the increased number of students and the co-location will affect my son's access to these services.

For the above reasons, I submit this affidavit in support of the Verified Petition in opposition to the proposed re-siting of Brownsville.
